



## **2010 Howard University Graduate and Professional Graduating Student Exit Survey**

*All Schools and Colleges*

### **Description**

The *Howard University Graduate and Professional Graduating Student Exit Survey* is administered annually to prospective candidates for graduation enrolled in all graduate/professional programs. The primary purpose of the survey is to obtain information about students' satisfaction with a range of academic and co-academic experiences during their matriculation and to inquire about their plans for the future. The survey was administered by the Office of Institutional Assessment and Evaluation (OIAE) through a web-based format with the assistance and cooperation for faculty and staff in the various schools and colleges. The results are presented in four sections: demographics, college/school assessment data, student quality of life data, and university community experience data. There were 720 respondents.
