

#### **Summer 2022 Course Evaluations**

### Howard University - Overall

At Howard University, The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (IRA) conducted course evaluations for 14 colleges and schools. Evaluations were made available to students on Sunday, June 12, 2022 and closed Wednesday, August 31, 2022. Faculty received course evaluations on Monday, May 16, 2022.\*

#### Across the university:

- 876 courses received at least one evaluation;
- 4737 evaluations were sent out to students;
- 932 evaluations were completed (response rate of 19.67%);
- A total of **19 questions** (8 course and 11 instructor) were asked across all departments.

In the tables below, a Likert scale rating (0-5) is included alongside a mean, standard deviation, and median. These ratings as well as the averages included below aggregate all student responses across the university. The averages are useful when understanding the general student experience across the evaluated courses and are useful in understanding faculty performance regardless of class size.

College of Pharmacy courses occurred on a non-traditional schedule this semester, so their course evaluations are not included in this general report.
